The Hamilton County Parks and Recreation Department (HCPR) manages thirteen parks encompassing more than 1,800 acres of forest, prairie, lake, riverfront, and trails. Visitors to Hamilton County Parks can swim, fish, horse-back ride, hike, kayak, canoe, enjoy an aerial obstacle course, or simply enjoy the beauty of nature found throughout Hamilton County. The Friends of Hamilton County Parks, established in 2006, engages community members and businesses in our mission to ensure that our parks meet the needs and expectations of Hamilton County residents and our visitors in amazing ways and assists in funding capital improvements.
